Call to Order:

The regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Lorain County Rural Wastewater District was held at the Eaton Township garage, 12043 Avon Belden Road, Grafton, Ohio. President McConnell called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with a remembrance of those who lost their lives and the families that were affected by the September 11, 2001 terrorist attacks on the United States of America. - 1) That in anticipation of receiving permanent construction funding with a financing guarantee from the USDA/ Rural Development, the LORCO Rural Wastewater District may be required to expend or incur cost for planning and/or fees for the purpose of making capital improvements to their wastewater collection facility, which costs expended or incurred will be considered a part of the total USDA/Rural Development construction loan and the LORCO Rural Wastewater District may claim such costs as reimbursable expenses through the loan.
- 2) That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Board of Trustees concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board of Trustees, and that all deliberations of the Board of Trustees and of any of its committees resulting in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of Ohio.

Executive Director, Alspach, shared the information of hours worked for LORCO, the LORCO Weekly Staff Report, several letters regarding easement agreements, a thank you to RLCWA for their support during the county fair and numerous news articles addressing sewer issues.
