RESOLUTION NO. 2017-33 2018 Permanent budget. It was moved by Lahetta, with a second by Wright to approve the resolution. The vote was as follows: 11 Yeas. 0 Nays. Motion carried.

Executive Director Report:

- Cinnamon Lake first LORCO bills went out 11/10/17. Total billed for November = \$48,769.36. 64% collected by due date. 75% collected by December billing date. Remainder was "balance forwarded" onto December bills. Working on developing lien procedure.
- 2. Having some issues with Barrington Phase 7. Seven homes connected but not inspected. Phase 7 infrastructure improvements not accepted yet. Sewer plug installed during construction done by contractor and not by Avon Lake. Will be working with contractor and Avon Lake to remedy these issues. Approval of Phase 8 sewer plans by Avon Lake is on hold pending a resolution to these issues.
- 3. Cinnamon Lake Plant Class 2 WWTP operator hour reduction was approved by Ohio EPA effective 12/6/17. Class 2 hours reduced from 20 hours/week to 10 hours/week.
- 4. Have been asked by Cinnamon Lake Utilities Association to attend their 12/18/17 board meeting.
- 5. Tim Ujvari, former City Engineer Elyria retired a couple of weeks ago. He called prior to his last day to say that Kathy McKillips, assistant city engineer was working on maps and parcel lists for potential FPA amendments. He will be off for two months, but she is supposed to be working on it in his absence.
- 6. Attending Water Quality Subcommittee tomorrow at NOACA in Cleveland.

Board President Kurpely asked Executive Director Toy to report on a recent meeting involving LORCO, West Salem, and several Wayne County officials
