- 2) Submitted Hawke Road FPA change to NOACA. As of now, all parties are in agreement. Columbia Township met on Monday.
- 3) Received request from Scott Dillen (Raintree Development) to initiate FPA change for Raintree parcels south of Butternut Ridge Road and within Elyria FPA. Met with Avon Lake Regional Water to discuss.
- 4) Call earlier this week from assistant county engineer Bob Klaiber. He wanted to discuss:
 - a. Connecting the home at the southeast corner of Hawke and Osborne to our sewer on the west side of Hawke Road.
 - b. Connecting the IGA grocery store at the southeast corner of Island Road and State Route 82 to the LORCO system.
 - c. Negotiate an agreement for connecting Eaton Estates to our collection system so that package plant can be decommissioned. The county has "significant debt" on package plant improvements for approximately the next 20 years. It is blended/bundled debt tied to numerous other county projects.
- 5) Attended April 6, 2021 Grafton proposed annexation hearing at county administration offices in Elyria. LORCO attorney Ryan Gembala from OMDP Law was also present. Hearing began at 9:30 and stopped at around 12:30 due to a scheduling conflict. Will continue 4/20/21 at 9:30 am. Service territory objections (either oral or written) were raised by LORCO; RLCWA, and LMRE.
- 6) Received semiannual lien check today from Ashland County auditor. April 2021 = \$11,418.49; April 2020 = \$8,818.22; April 2019 = \$2,342.73.
