RESOLUTION NO. 2015-15 Carrington Pointe Resolution to Proceed. It was moved by Wright, with a second by Kurpely to approve the resolution. Executive Director provided a summary of the project - Phase 1 of Carrington Pointe - 18 sublots. Two of these front on Banks Road and are already served. Sublot 7 is an "old" existing home with a mound system. Sublot 13 is a "new" existing home with a mound system. Sublot 14 is a home under construction that is almost done; Plan is to install approximately 2,701' of 3" diameter low pressure force main at a depth of approximately 4'; Engineer's estimate is \$226,128 and assumed 15 sublots. As per the mapping we first received from the bank, sublot 10 was not always split. County auditor records show it as split into "10A" and "10B". \$226,128/15 = \$15,075. \$230,483/16 = \$14,405; Electrical/connection costs are not part of the engineer's estimate: There will not be a minimum monthly charge on vacant lots: Regarding temporary tanks, it is not likely that Avon Lake will be able to help; In order to require connections and assess, crocks and pumps need to be part of the project (similar to Phase 1); Will not install pumps now on vacant properties but will install crocks; Assessments will be made now on vacant lots or properties required to connect. There will be an assessment on Sublot 13 when required to connect; Looking at OWDA financing. Depending on loan application, interest rate will probably be approximately 3%. Can start with assessments on vacant lots. Paid off when property is transferred and home is built. Similar to Phase 1. \$15,000, 20 years at 5% interest = \$597.54/half. Plan to make all pumps and crocks part of bidding and project; Have received legal notice from Avon Lake Regional Water. Tentative bid date is 7/21/15. The vote was as follows: 14 Yeas. 0 Nays. Motion carried.
