**RESOLUTION NO. 2024-18 Approve Reauthorization of Funds.** It was moved by Roig, with a second by Beran to approve the resolution. Kurpely asked Toy to provide a brief explanation. Purpose for the Reauthorization of Funds is to revise the 2024 budget to reflect Ohio Department of Development ARPA Project 182722 payments to DRS Enterprises for the Phase 1 manhole replacement project.
